

As glaciers melt at an accelerated rate, a water molecule unfrozen after 4000 years goes on a journey around the world trying to revisit an old friend – a 4000 year old tree. Will it successfully reach the tree and find its friend alive?

#### **BIRTH**

Water and Seed meet for the first time, 4000 years ago, the life of a tree taking birth at their union. They spend many weeks together, unlocking the ancient powers of nature and creating life in a desert.

They part as the water molecule evaporates and rises to the sky, hoping to meet again when the water comes back down, though the sapling might well be a full grown tree by then.

Woolly Mammoth has just gone extinct.

The water molecule gets trapped in a glacier and freezes in position.

#### REBIRTH/ AGE IS JUST A NUMBER

4000 years have passed. The tree grows old and weak. Trees around it have long gone, but its strong roots still retain some water...and some hope. Humans have wreaked havoc on the environment.

The water molecule unfreezes and learns of what all has happened over the last 4000 years from its friends in the river and the sea.

#### LAST OF MY KIND

The land is unrecognizable. The map of the world has changed drastically from the time the water molecule has last travelled around it. The water molecule visits critically endangered animals and asks what it can do for them. They ask for only one thing — a flood to wipe humans away and provide a fresh start.

#### WATER, WATER, EVERYWHERE

Floods ravage countries all over the world, damage human property and provide lands with groundwater and search for the ancient tree. The water molecules unite to find the ancient tree in its final stages of life.
